And while it is unrehearsed – just as life is – true improv is rooted in the practice of solid communication skills, making it beneficial for individuals on the autism spectrum who are working on social skills and language development.

Yes, AND! interactive programming:

- Explores creative improv-based exercises that support the social, behavioral, and communication goals of individuals on the spectrum.
- Is interpreted and customized for individuals on the spectrum.
- Follows the rules of listening, affirmation, repetition, effective communication, and conversation.
- Is presented through games and activities that engage participants in play-based learning.
- Works to reinforce and develop skills such as eye contact, spontaneous language, conversation, empathy, accessing emotions, storytelling, and listening.
