# Clinical Services

## *Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Therapy Services*

- ABA therapy uses systematic, evidence-based methods to improve socially significant behaviors. Because treatment plans cover all areas of development – from communication to self-help to sensory and coping skills, it is usually delivered at a high dosage, ranging from 10-40 hours per week of 1:1 therapy. ABC of NC provides ABA therapy services in a center-based model.
- Some private health insurance plans provide coverage for ABA therapy services, while others do not. Check with your employer's HR department and/or your insurance plan to inquire about coverage. ABC of NC is also a credentialed Medicaid ABA therapy provider.
- Families on ABC of NC's waiting list for ABA therapy services will automatically be placed on the waiting list for our "Get Connected" program, a parent/caregiver program designed to help families gain confidence using autism-specific, evidence-based strategies; feel empowered as a parent/caregiver of a child with autism; and develop skills to help troubleshoot challenges at home and in the community.

- ABC of NC is a year-round, licensed, non-public school, nationally accredited through Cognia®. We provide educational programs for children preschool through high school.
- Autism diagnosis is not required; clinical/educational documentation of 'at-risk' or demonstrating autism characteristics required.

## Financial Assistance for School Services

### **1. ABC of NC Financial Aid Program**

- Families with total household income of \$150,000 or less are eligible to apply. Award amounts are based on sliding fee scale.

### **2. State-Funded Early Intervention Program**

- Children must be 60 months or younger at intake.

  - No prior requirement of public school enrollment

  - Income-based eligibility criteria
  - No prior requirement of public school enrollment for grades K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>
