She is also the author of nine bestselling and award-winning books including the foundational The Asperkids (Secret) Book of Social Rules, groundbreaking memoir Autism in Heels, and upcoming My Friend Julia: A Sesame Street Book About Autism. She sits on the Autism Society of America's Council of Autistic Advisors and is a multi-award-winning, international presenter who has spoken everywhere from the White House. to the National Institutes of Health, to royal audiences in Europe.
